To add to the excitement of winning an award, you also win a cash prize. These are first, second and third place in each category – photography, art and poetry. The first prize is £250, the second prize is £150 and the third prize is £75. Please ensure you send your work to the correct address below, we wouldn't want any of your work to be misplaced or sent elsewhere.

Make sure you put your name, address and phone number on the back of your submission. Each piece of work submitted must have a signed declaration that the work is all your own. Entries submitted after the deadline will not be put forward. The winners will be announced at our next Annual General Meeting.
